Additionally, there will be an opportunity for members of the public to comment at a specified time during the meeting.

 - iv. A prompt titled "Join Meeting" will pop up. Here, please do the following:

 - 3. Check the box titled "turn off my video"
- 2. You will enter a waiting room. Once admitted, you will have access to the meeting.
