 - ii. Dock Bay #108 42 Yard Compactor:
 - 1. RJ 225 / Model #318549 / Serial # 8-25-04 / Date of MFG. 2000-03
 - iii. Dock Bay #208 42 yard Compactor:
 - 1. RJ 225 / Model #318550 / Serial # 8-25-04 / Date of MFG. 2000-03
